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# **TECHNO BOND 50**

( PVA BONDING AGENT ) Confirms to BS 2354-1974 ASTM C 631-70

#### **DESCRIPTION**

• TECHNO BOND-50 is a resin based multipurpose adhesive for the construction industry as a bonding additive to concrete and plasters. Upon drying it forms a strong film which is non-staining and non -discoloring.

#### **USES**

- For concrete repairing
- For building up of compression
- To give greater adhesion to mortar and plaster.
- As a general purpose adhesive for bonding-Tiles, Concrete, Roofing, Linoleum polystyrene etc.
- As a primer for over coating bitumen

#### **ADVANTAGES**

- Alkali resistant
- Can be applied to damp surface, without puddles or brittleness.
- Once cured, it is flexible and remains unaffected to climatic and weather conditions.
- · Works on traction and shearing.
- Non hazardous & non toxic.
- Can be used as a filler by diluting 1: 1 with water, and add suitable bulk ingredient such as plaster, clean fine sand

#### **APPLICATION**

- As general purpose adhesive: TECHNO BOND-50 should be used in concentrated form (as supplied) 20-30 minutes should be allowed for setting.
- Priming: porous and dusty surface should be cleaned with primer solution made up of 1 part of water to 4 parts of TECHNO BOND-50, or as necessary.
- Keying:- The bonding coat to be made up of 2 parts of water to 1 of TECHNO BOND-50-apply by brush and whilst the coating is still wet carry out plastering for rendering.
- Screeding: after priming the floor surface make up a screeding compound using 1 part Portland cement, mixed with 3 parts sand. Make it to a workable consistency by mixing TECHNO BOND-50 (in 1 part of Techno Bond -50-to 8 parts of water).
- As a concrete admixture: TECHNO BOND-50 is added at the rate of 25 -35 liters per 100 kg of cement.
- As filler: dilute 1:1 with water and add a suitable bulk ingredient such as plaster cement fine sand etc.
- For industrial floor:- use 1 part of sand, 1 part of cement, 2 parts of 3-6 mm granite chip and 25 liter of TECHNO BOND-50 per 100 kg cement.
- As a bonding coat:-use undiluted-1 part of TECHNO BOND-50 with 2 parts of water. For porous surfaces, apply two coats in successions.
- Splatter coat: 2 parts of clean sharp sand, 1 part of cement to 1 part of TECHNO BOND-50 mixed with 3 parts of water.
